For young children, we provide a travel cot, a high chair, a stroller. No need to overload the car or get cluttered at the airport to take the plane.


To have the fridge stocked when you arrive, think about the drive-through to pick up on arrival (Carrefour Laloubère, Leclerc Méridien).

The suites and rooms have reversible air conditioning. Each room controls its temperature via a wall box. Remember to close the doors and windows when you use it! If you go for a walk and you are not inside, we advise you to turn it off.



The kitchen is equipped with a 4-burner gas stove with 2 ovens, an electric kettle, a toaster, a washing machine, a dishwasher and a Senseo coffee machine. Pods are provided (but for coffee lovers, it is better to bring some in your luggage or in your drive-through).



It is possible to eat around the same table of 14 people.



We are committed to respecting the environment. Also, we will ask you to respect the sorting instructions: yellow bin for recyclables, green bin for the rest, a glass point is located on the village square. In case of non-compliance with these instructions, a flat rate of €90 will be taken from your deposit.

We have a composter near the vegetable garden where you can throw your vegetable peelings.

For the rest, you can give it to our chickens who will love it. Thank you!

## The essentials



The estate has a quick tennis court (porous concrete). We ask you to respect the premises by taking away your waste and sweeping before and after use. Accessible from June to September from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.



The houses have access to the swimming pool area of the estate. Children are not allowed to use the swimming pool without the presence of an adult to supervise them. You can change in the changing rooms provided for this purpose. You will also find a shower and toilets on site.

It is best to use your bath towels; the bathroom linen provided in the houses is not intended for this.

The swimming pool and the summer kitchen are open from June 15 to September 15 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. It is therefore not possible to use the summer kitchen for evenings or dinners.

The pool is not heated.




The houses are equipped with a barbecue. A bag of charcoal is provided. We will ask you to clean the grills well for the next holidaymakers.



Remember to pack your swimsuits, swimming equipment, sunscreen and bath towels in your luggage.

If you plan to spend several days, consider charcoal for the barbecue.

For your comfort upon arrival, we provide toilet paper, hygiene products (soap, etc.) and trash bags. Remember to add them to your list to extend your stay peacefully.




This unique configuration isolates the numerous deep valleys, true natural microcosms, still preserved by this stone wall.



## The internal regulations

### **Article 1: Legal obligations**

Under Article L.324-2 of the Tourism Code, the conclusion of a written contract for any seasonal rental is obligatory.

This is why, before entering the premises, when the keys are handed over, you will be asked, with the owner or any person authorized by the latter, to carry out and sign a written inventory. A rental contract will also be validated and signed as well as these internal regulations.

### Article 2: the security deposit

A security deposit (or bond) will be required, regardless of the length of your stay. It will not be cashed.

In the event of damage, anomalies noted or unpaid sums, the owner has two months to return it to you, less the amount of the repairs to be carried out or the amount of the tenant's debts to him.

#### **Article 3: Insurance**

The tenant is asked to provide proof of insurance during their stay.

Very often, you have a clause called vacation guarantee in your multi-risk home insurance contract.

This clause is generally sufficient to guarantee the rental of furnished tourist accommodation during your vacation.

Check that your contract includes this holiday guarantee. If not, you can take out specific insurance with the insurer of your choice for the rental period of the furnished accommodation.

### Article 4: Use of the premises

The houses are not rented for use as a principal residence or for mixed professional and principal residence use.

## The internal regulations

Consequently, the respective rights and obligations of tenants and owners will be governed by the provisions of this contract, by the decree of December 28, 1976 as amended and, failing that, by the provisions of the civil code.

The houses, the subject of this contract, are rented furnished and on a seasonal basis.

### **Article 5: Arrival and departure**

In order to allow for cleaning of the premises, arrival at the houses begins at 5:00 p.m. Departure is at 10:00 a.m.

When entering the premises, you will be asked to pay the balance of the rental if deposits have been paid.

### **Article 6: Cleanliness of the premises**

The cleaning carried out by the owner between each rental does not exempt the owner from returning the houses in a clean condition: vacuuming, mopping the floors, putting the dishes away, etc. A flat rate of €150 may be deducted from the deposit if the cleaning is not done.

art.6-1 trash cans

We ask you to sort your waste correctly (see welcome guide and Symat brochures).

If the containers reserved for guests are full, it is your responsibility to throw away your garbage bags and your "glass" waste in the center of the village in the points provided for this purpose. A flat rate of €90 may be deducted from the deposit if the garbage is not put away in the containers or if the sorting instructions have not been respected.

• art.6-2 barbecues

If you use barbecues, remember to clean the grills thoroughly and throw away any ashes or barbecue residue.

• art.6-3 cigarette butts

We ask you not to throw your cigarette butts anywhere but in ashtrays.

Additional cleaning fees (€150) may be deducted from the security deposit in the event of non-compliance with this article.

### Article 7: Behavioural noise and noise pollution

The tenant must ensure the peaceful nature of the rental and use it in accordance with the purpose of the premises. Festive events are permitted provided that they comply with the terms of the law.

Behavioural noises are all noises caused during the day or at night: by a tenant (shouting, singing, partying, etc.), or by a thing (musical instrument, hi-fi system, audio speakers, etc.), or by an animal (barking).

Due to the proximity of neighbors, no audio equipment is permitted in the pool area.

### **Article 8: Modesty**

We ask that you do not walk around the property in a swimsuit (outside the pool area) and we ask that you adopt a decent attitude when moving around.

Changing rooms are available for you to change in when you want to go to the pool area.

### Article 9: access to the swimming pool and summer kitchen

The swimming pool and the summer kitchen are accessible from 8am to 6pm. It is possible to have lunch on site: a barbecue, a plancha, a pizza oven, a fridge, a freezer, a dishwasher, a sink are at your disposal until 6pm.

Throughout the stay, children are the responsibility of their parents, particularly for access to the swimming pool area.

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## The internal regulations

The estate, with its swimming pool and river, may present drowning hazards: do not let children wander around alone without being accompanied by their parents or a responsible adult. In accordance with current regulations, the swimming pool is protected by an alarm detecting movements outside access hours.

#### **Article 10: Access to tennis**

Tennis is available during the day from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Before leaving, it is best to sweep, take away your rubbish and loosen the net slightly.

#### Article 11: maintenance of the estate

During your stay, we may be required to mow, water or maintain the pool. As much as possible, we will ensure that your privacy is respected.

### **Article 12: Animals**

Small pets are allowed in the rented houses. They must, like their master, respect the premises and accommodate the different animals already present on the estate (cat, chickens and rooster, horses). You can feed the chickens with the leftovers of your meals. Do not leave leftover food outside because of the nightly passage of foxes.

### **Article 13: health regulations**

Due to current health risks, we ask our guests to commit to respecting the barrier gestures in force and to ensure that no one has Covid-19 symptoms or is positive at the time of arrival.

### **Article 14: Internet connection**

Downloading is illegal. The tenant agrees to respect the laws regarding downloads and site visits. In the event of a request from the competent authorities, the owner may transmit the contact details of the tenant who benefited from said connection.

### **Article 15: Sanctions**

In the event of non-compliance with these internal regulations, the owner may collect the security deposit or even terminate the rental contract at any time without reimbursement of the nights not used.
